In addition to the numerous topics mentioned above, Dr. Cheney also addresses the following: sleep issues, blood volume, candida, chlamydia, lyme disease, multiple chemical sensitivity (MCS), fibromyalgia (FM), gulf war syndrome (GWS), phenotypic and genotypic changes in DNA, hyperbaric oxy-

gen, and the use of stem cells from umbilical cord blood.

ORDERING INFORMATION

The DVDs are not region coded, so work in all regions. The discs are in NTSC format. However, all PAL DVD players output NTSC.

When ordering please tell us the media type compatible with your DVD player (DVD-R, DVD+R, or both). If you don't know the media type, refer to the owner's manual. DVD-R is most common.

If you do not have a DVD player, we now have VHS available. However, they are in NTSC format and unlike the DVDs, may not work where PAL format is used.
